## Hartlebury Castle

**Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> June Meet at Castle at 10.50 am**

The castle opens at 10 am for those who wish to have a coffee before the visit commences. Please meet at the reception area next to the café at 10.50 am. We will then have a talk about the history of the castle and how the books in the Hurd library were collected. A tour of the castle will follow and the visit will finish at 1 pm. If we are a large group we will be split into two groups. The castle has recently undergone considerable redevelopment. The café will be open at the close of the visit for anyone who wants to have lunch but they need to know in advance if numbers are high. If you also wish to stay and visit the County Museum, which is on the same site, you can do so for an additional £2.50, bringing a picnic or having lunch in the café.
