### A VISIT TO THE TERRACOTTA WARRIORS EXHIBITION AT THE WORLD MUSEUM LIVERPOOL

For over 2000 years an underground army of life size terracotta warriors secretly guarded the tomb of China's 1st Emperor Qin Shi Huang until a chance discovery in 1974.

The exhibition of over 180 artefacts, some on show for the first time in the UK, is at the World Museum Liverpool from 9th February to 28th October 2018. The exhibition spans 1000 years of Chinese History and sheds light on the Emperor's pursuit of immortality and shows how he prepared for the afterlife.

There is the opportunity to visit other galleries at the Museum, or visit other parts of Liverpool before returning to Worcester.
