

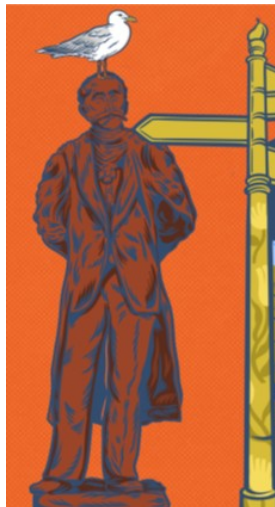
Welcome to The Community Arts Page of the Arts Society Worcester and its celebration of the installation of Foregate Street Station Art Installation in the spring of 2024.

A team of partners led by The Arts Society Worcester commissioned local artist Estee Angeline to create a vibrant work with colours inspired by The Worcester Colour Palette designed by the Colour Palette Company. Lining the walls of the underpass between the two platforms the design brightens the area and points visitors towards local destinations and sites of interest.



Turning Left from the Station you are en route to

- The Commandery - Royalist Stronghold during the Battle of Worcester (1)
- Fort Royal Hill (2)
- Museum of Royal Worcester – Home of the Worcester Porcelain collection (3)
- The Cathedral (6)
- Friar Street (7)
- Elgar Statue (8)
- Glovers Needle (9)



Heading directly West from the Station (ie Straight up the Butts)
You'll find:

- The Hive (12) our wonderful golden library and a unique shared space belonging to both City and University
- The Arches – with many independent cafes, bars and restaurants and our friends at the Artery in Arches 28 and 29 who are encouraging and supporting the Artists of Worcester



You'll need to cross to the other side of the River Severn to visit:

- The Cricket Ground –often described as the most picturesque Cricket Pitch in England with its backdrop of the Cathedral (5)
- The Diglis Fish Pass (4)
- University Campus St Johns (11)



Turning Right from the Station you are heading in the direction of :

- Worcester City Art Gallery and Museum (18)
- The University Art House
- University Castle Street Campus
- The Swan Theatre (16)
- Pitchcroft an amazing green space by the River Severn with its Racecourse (15) and Rowing Club (10) the location of Worcester Pitchcroft Parkrun on Saturday mornings and regular haunt of dog walkers and runners



You'll need to head further North out of town to reach:

- Gheluvelt Park – memorial park to those lost in the Battle of Gheluvelt in 1918 Full of beautiful trees it is home to a bandstand, tennis courts, a children's play area and many ducks and squirrels
