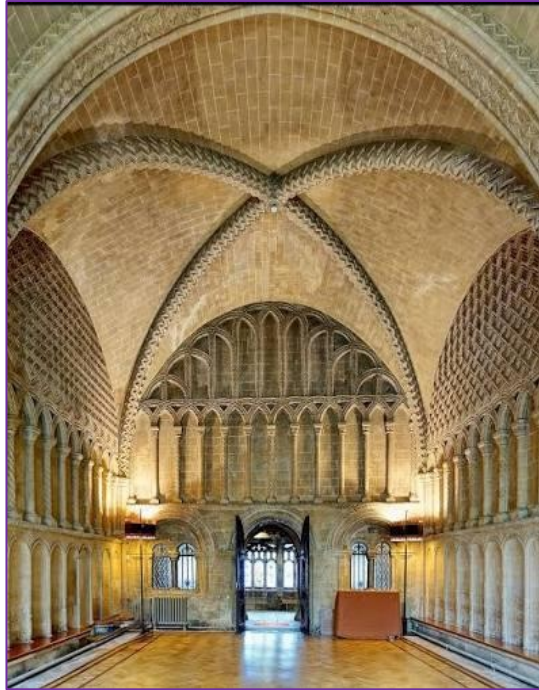


Medieval to Modern in Bristol

Bristol Cathedral

Aerospace Bristol & Concorde

In the afternoon we travel to Aerospace Bristol, home to one of Britain's finest collections celebrating over a century of aviation history. The museum tells the story of Bristol's pioneering role in aircraft design and manufacture through an impressive collection of aircraft, engines, helicopters and interactive displays.

The highlight of our visit is an exclusive guided tour aboard **Concorde Alpha Foxtrot (G-BOAF)**, the last Concorde ever to be built and the final aircraft to fly. Our knowledgeable guide will explain the extraordinary engineering behind this iconic supersonic airliner, its remarkable achievements and the experience of travelling at twice the speed of sound.

After the guided tour there will be time to explore the museum further at your own pace and relax in the café before our return journey.
