The most populous city in Scotland. Glasgow has so much to offer, from art galleries and museums, to shopping, said to be the second largest shopping area in the British Isles after London.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY

Day 1 Monday 27th - Travel to Glasgow. Join your local coach to Birmingham airport for your flight to Glasgow. On arrival at the airport, your Glasgow coach transfer will transport you to the Burrell Museum with time to visit and look round before being taken to the Ibis Styles hotel late afternoon. Time to settle in to your room before dinner is served.

Day 2 Tuesday 28th - Riverside Museum and Tall Ships. After breakfast, visit the Riverside Museum this morning and the Tall Ships. Enjoy a free afternoon to visit the House of the Art Lover, or maybe the Clydeside distillery, alternatively why not some retail therapy browsing through the great shopping centre. You will have a free evening at your own leisure to obtain an evening meal.

Day 3 Wednesday 29th - Merchant City, Cathedral and Neocropolis tour. After another hearty breakfast, take a tour of the Merchant city and discover the past of this beautiful city. Today you will also enjoy an architectural walk round the area followed by a visit to the cathedral and a Neocropolis tour. Relax in the hotel before enjoying your meal at the Ardnamurchan restaurant.

Day 4 Thursday 30th. Join your coach for a scenic tour through the beautiful borders to Dumfries House for an informative Grand tour followed by 3-course lunch. This will be a fantastic experience not to be missed. Return to the hotel early evening.

Day 5 Friday 31st - Travel home. After breakfast, we say farewell to our hosts and make our first visit to the Hunterian Art Gallery, followed by a guided tour of Mackintosh House before your coach transfer back to the airport for your flight returning to Birmingham, where your local coach transfer will be waiting to take you home.

HOTEL INFORMATION

The 3* standard Ibis Styles Hotel is located in George Square in Glasgow City Centre, just a 7-minute walk from Glasgow Central Train Station. Hotel facilities include a restaurant and bar. Room facilities feature a flat-screen TV with satellite channels, a modern en-suite bathroom, free toiletries, a hairdryer and tea/coffee making facilities. The hotel has a lift but no on site coach parking.
