Visit to Frans Hals Exhibition at National Gallery

Thursday 5th October



A rare opportunity to see an extraordinary collection of the work of the Painter of the Dutch Golden Age, Frans Hals.

Eclipsed by his contemporaries Rembrandt and Vermeer, Hals is often overlooked and known only for his most famous work *The Laughing Cavalier* (which has been lent for the first time to this exhibition by the trustees of the Wallace Collection).

Sometimes dismissed as a genre artist his skill and deftness of touch has to be seen in the flesh to be appreciated.
